## Two People Dead, Two Injured in Evening Shooting

On December 27, 2017 at approximately 8:01 p.m. LVMPD Patrol officers were dispatched to a residence located in the 3700 block of East Bonanza Road to investigate multiple reports of a shooting and several people injured. Arriving officers located four adults inside of the residence who had been shot. One man and one woman were pronounced deceased at the scene by medical personnel. Another man and woman were transported to UMC Trauma where the woman was described as having potentially life-threatening injuries.

While officers were responding to the residence, other officers were dispatched to the 1800 block of East Bonanza Road to make contact with another 911 caller who indicated she and other occupants of her vehicle had been involved in a fight and shooting with individuals at the residence listed above. This caller was later identified as 38-year-old Juwanna Chapman-Doucet.

The investigation initiated by the LVMPD Homicide Section indicated a family member of Chapman-Doucet was involved in a domestic dispute at the residence where the shooting occurred. Chapman-Doucet drove from her home in California with her boyfriend, later identified as 46-year-old Clarence Wilson, and another adult male. Chapman-Doucet, Wilson, and the other man arrived at the residence and asked to use the restroom. While in the residence, a physical altercation took place between a male resident of the house and the male who arrived with Chapman-Doucet.

Chapman-Doucet left the residence and retrieved a handgun from her car and gave it to Wilson. While Chapman-Doucet's family member and other passenger were leaving the house, Wilson reportedly fired multiple rounds towards the residence. All of them

got into the car and drove down the street where they called police and were contacted by officers.

As a result of the investigation, detectives arrested Clarence Wilson and transported him to the Clark County Detention Center where he faces charges of:

- Murder with deadly weapon (2 counts)
- Attempted murder with deadly weapon (2 counts)
- Discharging a firearm into an occupied structure (9 counts)
- Prohibited person in possession of a firearm

Juwanna Chapman-Doucet was also arrested and faces one count of sale or transfer of a firearm to a prohibited person. Booking photos of Wilson and Chapman-Doucet accompany this release.

The identity of the deceased victims, as well as the cause and manner of death, will be released by the Clark County Coroner's Office.
