Man Killed Over Loud Music Dispute

On January 16, 2018 at approximately 3:13 p.m. LVMPD patrol officers were dispatched to an apartment complex located in the 2200 block of West Bonanza Boulevard to investigate a report of a man shot. Arriving officers located an unresponsive adult male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to UMC Trauma where he was pronounced deceased.

The LVMPD Homicide investigation indicated that 37-year-old Stavros Stathakos became involved in a verbal altercation over the victim playing loud music from his vehicle. As the victim was walking away, Stathakos pulled out a handgun and shot the victim multiple times. Stathakos then walked back to his apartment where he was taken into custody without incident.

As a result of the investigation, Stathakos was booked into the Clark county Detention Center for one count of Murder with a Deadly Weapon.

The identity of the victim, as well as the cause and manner of death, will be released by the Clark County Coroner's Office.
