Male Shot and Killed Inside Residence

Detectives Asking for Public's Assistance Identifying Suspect Vehicle

On December 12, 2017 at approximately 10:01 p.m. patrol officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Twain Circle where a male had been shot inside of the residence. Arriving officers located an unresponsive male inside of a bedroom with multiple gunshot wounds. He was pronounced deceased at the scene by responding medical personnel.

The investigation initiated by the LVMPD Homicide Section indicated that three individuals entered the residence without force. Once inside, they went directly into the bedroom were the victim was located. Various shots were heard and the three males fled the residence in an unknown direction.

The identity of the victim, as well as the cause and manner of death, will be released by the Clark County Coroner's Office.

The three suspects were described as black male adults wearing dark hoodies and blue jeans.

Update – Suspect Vehicle

The LVMPD Homicide Section is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspects responsible for the murder of Tyrone Johnson at 3659 Twain Circle. Johnson was shot inside the residence and the suspects fled the scene in a dark colored minivan.
