Detectives Seek to Identify Suspect in Child Luring Case

On February 12, 2018 at approximately 8:48 a.m. LVMPD patrol officers were dispatched to Saville Middle School to investigate a report of an attempted luring of a child. Officers made contact with school personnel who indicated a student had been riding a bike to school when a man pulled up next to him in a car and tried to lure the juvenile into the vehicle. The victim was able to leave the area and reported the incident to school officials.

The investigation initiated by the LVMPD Northwest Area Command Patrol Investigations Section indicated the victim was in the area of Mustang Street and Horse Drive in the Northwest part of the Las Vegas valley when the suspect pulled up next to the victim and attempted to get the victim to get into his vehicle. The victim was able to get to school and report the attempt, and the suspect drove away in an unknown direction.

The suspect was described as a white male who appeared to be about 60 years old with a thin build and grey hair. The vehicle was described as a newer model red or burgundy four-door sedan.
