LVMPD Detectives Need Assistance to Identify Suspect

On March 18, 2018 at approximately 2:53 a.m. LVMPD patrol officers were dispatched to reports of a shooting in the 600 block of East Fremont Street. Arriving officers located two victims with non-life threating injuries at the scene. A third victim self-transported to University Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries.

The preliminary investigation by LVMPD Gang Investigations showed a group of adults got into a fight near 6th and Fremont Streets. Immediately after the fight began, two to three of the individuals in the fight pulled out firearms and fired multiple rounds striking three innocent bystanders. 29-year-old Dustin Pellican was taken into custody at the scene. A second suspect is still outstanding.

Pellican was booked into the Clark County Detention Center where he faces charges for:

- Attempt Murder with a Deadly Weapon
- Battery with a Deadly Weapon (x2)
- Conspiracy Murder
- Own/Posses Gun by Prohibited person
- Conspiracy Battery with a Deadly Weapon (x2)

Defectives need assistance in identifying the outstanding suspect who is described as an 18 to 24 year-old Hispanic male, wearing a black hat, black jacket, and tan pants.
