## **Suspects Sought in String of Thefts**

Beginning on March 22, 2018 at approximately 6:30 p.m. LVMPD patrol officers were dispatched to the parking garage of a casino located in the 3600 block of South Las Vegas Boulevard to investigate a report of a robbery. The victim had been walking to his car when he was approached by two adult male suspects who began to speak with the victim. The suspects followed him into the garage, and then one of the suspects wrestled a bag away from the victim that contained personal property. The men were last seen walking south on Las Vegas Boulevard.

At about 8:10 p.m. the same day, LVMPD officers were dispatched to the 3700 block of South Las Vegas Boulevard to investigate a case of pickpocketing. A victim was walking outside of a casino and had personal property taken from his back pocket. On April 23 another victim made a station report advising that on April 22 at about 10:15 p.m. she had her purse stolen from next to her while she was at a casino in the 3600 block of South Las Vegas Boulevard.

Detectives with the Convention Center Area Command Patrol Investigations Section determined two suspects were responsible for all three crimes. Photos of the two suspects accompany this release.
